## **Band History**

- QCJPD was founded in 2015 by members of the Charlotte piping/drumming community with the following goals in mind:
  - Teach youth the great highland bagpipes and drums
  - Offer a safe environment, following a proven educational model
  - Build a band capable of competently performing and competing in the Southeast
  - Provide instruction, equipping, and outfitting at a reasonable cost
- The band has performed many times locally and competed in the Loch Norman, Greenville, and Scotland County Highland games
- The group has grown from just a handful of players to over 20 students

## **Band Funding and Cost to Run**

- To date, the only cost to students has been a one-time \$120 fee for the introductory 10-week session. This covers:
  - Practice chanter, reed, and instruction book for pipers
  - Drumsticks/mallets, practice pad and book for drummers
- The following costs have been absorbed by a few performance fees, fund-raisers, and the lending of personal equipment, but mostly from monetary donations:
  - Quarterly insurance premiums covering the band members, instructors, and rehearsal hall
  - All members: Uniforms
  - Pipers: Bagpipes, reeds, and maintenance items
  - o Drummers: Drums, drum heads, harnesses, and cases
  - Entrance fees and supplies for competitions, and incentive items (student store)
- The band is very fortunate to have the use of Myers Park Presbyterian Church at no charge for its rehearsals

## Membership Fee -- Why?

- After the 10-week introductory course, costs continue but student contributions cease
- The funds for uniforms, instruments, insurance, and competition fees typically end up coming out of the instructors' pockets
- All instructors are volunteers, and most have no students in the band
- Learning to play an instrument is an investment, not only in time and effort, but monetarily -- most private lessons average > \$25 for a 30 minute lesson
- Students that are financial invested (backed by their parents) in a program are more likely to practice, attend rehearsals, and actively participate

## **About the Ongoing Membership Fee**

- Starts after the conclusion of a paid initial 10-week session
- \$20/month per student
- Families with multiple students are \$10/month after first student, capping at \$40
- Due at the start of each month
- First month free if yearly dues paid in advance
- Students will not be charged for any month the band is dormant

## Comparing the Fee to Other Youth Activities

• AYSO: \$160 per season<sup>1</sup>

Karate: \$45-105- per month<sup>2</sup>

• Gymnastics: \$150-300 per month<sup>3</sup>

Music lessons: \$15-45 per 30 minute lesson<sup>4</sup>

Scouting: \$25-40 per year, plus local dues, plus uniform and event fees<sup>5</sup>

• QCPD: \$20 per month, or \$200 per year when paid in advance typically

(QCPD is typically dormant in December)
